Tanin E2F[®]



Tanin E2F[®] is gallic and chestnut tannins put to solution for sparkling wines. Contains sulphites.



PRODUCT CHARACTERISTICS

- ◆ **Formulation:** Gallic and chestnut tannins put to solution. Contains sulphites (E220).
- ◆ **Enological benefits:** Tanin E2F[®] can be used to **improve the structure and organoleptic qualities** of base wines before the secondary fermentation. When used with a riddling agent, it helps to create a compact deposit, for optimal riddling. Added at disgorging, it helps balancing the mouthfeel.
Tanin E2F[®] helps to conserve wines' redox potential for optimal ageing (prevents reductive notes and protects against oxidation).
- ◆ **Protection role :** Natural antioxidant, blocks polyphenol oxidases and improves the effectiveness of SO₂.
- ◆ **Stabilisation role :** Causes the precipitation of unstable proteins and protects the organoleptic qualities of wines.
- ◆ **Organoleptic role :** Adds elegance and structure to white wines without adding astringency.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- ◆ When used at tirage, to be added with yeasts and adjuvant to the wine. Always add Tanin E2F[®] first and ensure a good homogenisation to the base wine before adding adjuvant.
- ◆ **Dosage:** 4 to 6 cL/hL.
