



Antitartre indice 40

Metatartaric acid esterification index 40 prepared under vacuum.
Inhibitor of tartrate precipitations.



PRODUCT CHARACTERISTICS

- ◆ **Formulation:** Metatartaric acid index 40 (E353).
- ◆ **Enological benefits:** Inhibitor of tartrate precipitations. **Prevents the crystallization of potassium bitartrate salts.**



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- ◆ Dissolve in 10 times its weight in cold water and add to the wine ensuring that the product is evenly distributed, at least 24 to 48 hours before the last filtration step.

General Precautions :

- Never use hot water to prepare it.
- If the wine is very cold, it may cause turbidity.
- Use Antitartre Indice 40 on wines previously stabilised against protein haze.

- ◆ **Dosage:** 10 g/hL.

- ◆ **Maximum legal dosage (UE regulation): 10 g/hL.**

- ◆ **Appearance & colour:** White to amber crystals

CHEMICAL

- ◆ **Purity:** > 99 %
- ◆ **Sulphates:** < 0,1 %
- ◆ **Tartaric acid content:** >105% (after hydrolyse)

LIMITS

- ◆ **Lead:** < 2 mg/kg
- ◆ **Arsenic:** < 3 mg/kg
- ◆ **Mercury:** < 1 mg/kg
- ◆ **Heavy metals (Ld):** < 10 mg/kg
- ◆ **Sulfuric ashes:** < 0,1 %



PACKAGING & CONSERVATION

- ◆ Bags of 1 kg (in 15 kg box) and bags of 5 kg (in 15 kg box).
- ◆ Store in its original packaging hermetically sealed, in a cool, clean and dry place without odors. Respect the optimal date of use written on packaging. Use quickly after opening.
