

PVPP Tab

PVPP in tablet form intended for the preventive or curative treatment of oxidation in musts and wines showing signs of oxidation, bitterness, or vegetal notes. Its non-powdery tablet format makes it easier to handle and use.



PRODUCT CHARACTERISTICS

- **Formulation:** Polyvinylpyrrolidone (PVPP – E1202). Tablet formulation.
- **Enological benefits:** Treatment that reduces the content of tannins and other polyphenols in must or wine in order to prevent browning, reduce astringency, and correct the colour and aromatic profile of wines. The use of PVPP Tab improves must clarification.

Its non-powder tablet form makes handling and dosing easier. Disperses easily and quickly upon contact with must or wine.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Allow to swell for 1 to 2 hours in 5 times its weight of water. Introduce slowly and evenly. Keep in suspension for at least 30 minutes by stirring or pumping over without aeration.
- **Dosage:** 1 PVPP Tab tablet weighs approximately 1 g to facilitate dosing.
 - Preventive: 10 - 20 g/hL
 - Curative: 20 - 60 g/hL

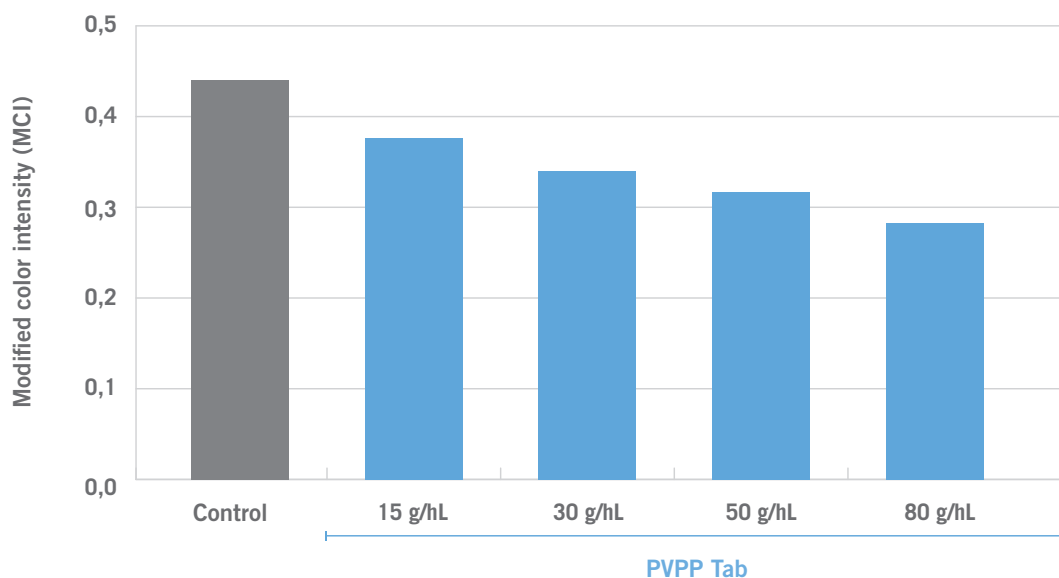
Maximum legal dosage (OIV Oenological Codex): 80 g/hL.
